ESSAY COMPETITION

Theme: Considering Tanzania's abundant extractive resources (Minerals and natural gas), how can the country harness its resources to drive sustainable development in the context of climate change?

Eligibility: Undergraduate and postgraduate students below 25 years of age as of September 2024.

Guidelines:

1. The essay must be action-oriented and propose innovative solutions addressing the sustainable development of Tanzania's extractive resources in the face of climate change.

2. A Maximum of 1000 words (excluding author profile and references).

3. Format:

i. Spacing: 1.5, with single spacing before and after each paragraph.

ii. Font Type: Arial, size 12.

iii. Submit in a Word (.doc/.docx) Document format.

4. Submission: Submit your essay by noon on October 11th, 2024 to lshao@hakirasilimali.or.tz, cc fmkasiwa@hakirasilimali.or.tz.

Include a short biodata/profile of the author within the document and attach a copy of your student ID

Selection Process: As part of the final selection process, shortlisted participants will be invited to make a brief presentation. Only shortlisted candidates will be contacted.

Award: Winners will be awarded a fully funded trip to attend the National Extractive Industries Conference (Jukwaa La Uziduaji 2024) in Dodoma from November 5 - 6. All costs associated with the conference (travel, accommodation, etc.) will be covered.

Deadline: October 11th, 2024 (12:00 PM).
